I contacted FBI Special Agent Joe Patricola who Johnson stated the investigated the matter. S/A Patricola stated that the "threat" that Alvarado made towards Johnson was part of a text message thread that was sent in the Fall of 2019. According to S/A Patricola, Johnson and Alvarado are co-workers and the incident stemmed from the employees unionizing. S/A Patricola stated that the threat was deemed to be non-imminent and that it would rise to the level of harassment.
