A few years ago, she turned our adoption journey into a nightmare. She presents herself as dedicated and professional in the initial meeting, but she is extremely disorganized and never return calls. She gets very annoyed when you finally reach her for a status update. She misplaced important documents several times, even to the point where she made a mad dash 30 minutes before our hearing to file documents.

During the hearing, the judge reprimanded her because there were still missing documents. She runs through assistants like crazy because she grinds them into the ground and leaves them to clean up her messes.

Keep in mind, I had a clean relative adoption. I had legal guardianship prior to hiring her. Because the child was born in a different state, we had to get an attorney from that state before getting one in Texas. This attorney did most of the work. Basically, all she had to do was file the paperwork he drew up and the customary ones required by Texas. All of the other Texas professionals hired or assigned to the case (social worker, amicus attorney, etc) expressed frustration throughout the process as well. Two days before our hearing after 5pm, she threatened to drop my case because I

voiced a concern about her asking me to get an important document notarized that she forgot to send to me. I could go on, trust me. If you hire her after reading this, you'll get all the bad, incompetent service you deserve.

I would NOT recommend working here. My time with Mrs. Brokaw was brief and miserable. She was very rude and often yelled at me for simple mistakes. For example, she was upset about a call that had gone straight to voicemail because I was on the other line speaking to a client. Mrs. Brokaw then began yelling & stomping her feet at me like a 2 year old having a temper tantrum. I don't know how old Mrs. Brokaw is, but she is too old to not know how to adequately channel her frustration. Often at times she would toss or shove papers at me, despite my hand being out ready to grab them. I frequently wondered what happened to her in her life to make her that aggressive. She was desperate for work but frequently mistreated me. I hope she knows that that type of behavior is unacceptable.

Her expectations of the time it should take to complete a given task were unrealistic. During the day she'd give me a set list of assignments then constantly interrupt, while I was in the middle of doing them, with other more "pressing" things to accomplish. Once I'd finish, she'd yell at me because the first task list wasn't completed. How could I finish it when you wanted me to stop & do something else? She did this multiple times throughout the day then accused me of not being able to multi task. Mrs. Brokaw takes the phrase multitasking too literally. I would answer the phone, book appointments, talk to clients who walked in through the front door, get them the necessary paperwork, and scan documents to the right of me. Despite all of that, she wanted me to work faster. If I wasn't doing every single thing she asked, including last minute interruptions, I'm working at a snails pace. One time I was filing away documents and still running back and forth to answer the phone yet she said to my face "you're not moving quick enough & getting nothing done". I was about to drop everything in my hand and walk out. I had done so much that day yet she still had complaints. The woman is never satisfied.

By the second day I wanted to quit. The way she spoke, not only to me, but to her clients was so disrespectful. She acted like everyone was wasting her time. And yet, each day I worked there she came later and later. Sometimes she had 10am in person meetings but would arrive well after the client showed up. Then the next client would come for their meeting. As a result, she now has 2 appointments waiting for her. Despite the fact that she was late, Mrs. Brokaw had the gall to blame me for the fact that clients were waiting because I "didn't get their paperwork ready quick enough". Yeah sure it's my fault and not the fact that you showed up to the office an hour and a half late.

Her filing system is in a disarray. There are important court documents floating in limbo somewhere around the office. It was alarming to me that she would lose such important faxes so easily. Often at times she'd asked me to retrieve a file and say it was "somewhere" in the office. Then she'd get upset with me if I couldn't find it, as if I was the one who lost it in the first place. On several occasions clients would call the office complaining that she had been ignoring their emails. When I would tell her she would yell at me for bothering her or "wasting her time".

For some strange reason she is very persistent about having a notary member in her office, so she pressures her assistants to register. The day of my interview she didn't ask but "demanded" that I sign up. If it's so important that her firm have someone who can notarize documents, Mrs. Brokaw could've simplified the situation by joining the notary public herself. Currently, in the state of Texas, you're required to agree to a \$10,000 surety bond when you become a notary. Basically, in the event of negligence or fraud, you would owe the affected party damages. The notary public would pay those damages for a balance of up to \$10,000. The person who holds the bond would then be responsible for paying back the notary public. My theory is that Mrs. Brokaw knows about the bond, and doesn't want to sign up for it, so she tries to shift that responsibility onto one of her assistants by pressuring them to sign up. She gave me the sign up sheet and demanded that I register by the end of the day. It costs a little over \$100 to register, yet she didn't even offer to reimburse me. The day she gave me the form just so happened to be the day I was quitting, so I ripped it up right before I walked out.

I hated every moment of working there. I could handle the heavy case loads, over abundance of clients, and documents under time constraints. What was too much was how rude Mrs. Brokaw was

to me. She made working there worse than it should've been. In the end I only lasted 2 weeks but it felt longer.
